Key Duties:	<ul> <li>To work within an established team of Secretaries in the general running of all medical secretarial aspects of The Horder Centre.</li> <li>To provide secretarial support to accredited Specialists practising at The Horder Centre.</li> <li>Type clinic letters and operation reports within the in-house computer (PIMS) programme via audio dictation from designated Specialists.</li> <li>Type all clinical correspondence as required.</li> <li>Filing, faxing, photocopying, distribution and retrieval of patients notes and X-rays etc, in line with The Horder Centre medical records management guidelines.</li> <li>Deal with telephone callers in an efficient and helpful manner, following The Horder Centre guidelines.</li> <li>Liaise with the Customer Services and Clinical Teams to effect the smooth running of clinics, ensuring that Consultant specific requirements are relayed and in place prior to consultations.</li> <li>Liaise with Consultants' private/NHS secretaries outside The Horder Centre.</li> <li>Arranging all diagnostic internal and external.</li> <li>Dealing with Private patient and costing of appointments and procedures.</li> </ul>
