<b>Key Duties:</b>	To be responsible for cleaning and to undertake all housekeeping duties to a high standard
<b>Key Accountabilities:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To take instruction from Duty housekeeper</li> <li>• To adhere to the signing in and out procedure as directed.</li> <li>• To follow the signing out and in procedure for keys held in the housekeeping key cupboard.</li> <li>• To clean, change and remake patient beds.</li> <li>• To clean patient bedrooms and en-suites</li> <li>• To clean day service unit to a high standard.</li> <li>• To clean patient lounge areas.</li> <li>• To clean and replenish shower rooms, toilet, and sluice and treatment rooms.</li> <li>• To clean offices and store areas.</li> <li>• To clean corridors, entrances and exit areas.</li> <li>• To sign off daily cleaning schedules for the areas that they have cleaned.</li> <li>• To collect and dispose of clinical, recycling and household waste.</li> <li>• To collect and dispose of fouled laundry.</li> <li>• To restock clean laundry store.</li> <li>• To maintain floors to a high standard of cleanliness using manual and electrical resources.</li> </ul>
