Key Duties:	<ul> <li>To work as part of the outpatient's team, delivering an unsupervised, high quality technical and specialist service. Performing visual assessments including; visual acuity, visual fields, optical coherence tomography (OCT), Oculus Pentacam, measurement of intraocular pressure and other technical measurements which provide information for clinical decisions/ treatments of eye and neurological conditions. The post holder will learn how to interpret the tests and report to consultant team.</li> <li>Actively develop positive team working between theatres and the ward</li> <li>To participate in integrated governance and risk assessment activities, reporting these as required.</li> <li>To undertake delegated responsibility for senior staff during short periods of absence.</li> <li>To report clinical incidents and complete all associated documentation as</li> </ul>
Key Knowledge, Skills and Experience:	<ul> <li>The post holder needs to have the expertise to undertake a range of visual fields that are requested by the medical staff.</li> <li>They will need to be able to highlight any concerns resulting from the field results to the doctors. At the end of testing the post holder is responsible for ensuring the saving of the data on a hard disk and maintaining the chronological order of the print outs in the notes for accurate record keeping.</li> <li>To maintain accurate records in OPD notes.</li> <li>The ability to explain clearly and precisely to the patient the nature and purpose of the test in a polite and professional manner. If necessary to utilise a range of verbal and non-verbal mechanisms in the assessment of patients. This will include patients who have difficulty in understanding the instructions.</li> <li>Promotes the development of an acceptable learning environment within the department.</li> <li>Provides the department nurses / learners with up to date information by acting as a link worker</li> <li>Participates in department development strategies and assists in the positive promotion of team building.</li> <li>Demonstrate a professional approach to work at all times</li> <li>Maintain confidentiality, privacy and dignity surrounding the patient/client 's admission and treatment at all times</li> <li>Ensure that mandatory and statutory training needs are met.</li> <li>Seeks to develop new skills.</li> <li>Understands and practices principles of equality and diversity</li> <li>Experience in the field of technician though qualifications or the equivalent practical experience</li> <li>GCSE passes including English and Maths at grade C or equivalent.</li> <li>IT skills</li> <li>Experience of working with the general public.</li> </ul>
